These funds can be used to start a business, purchase real estate, fund business renovations or expansions, and even purchase new machinery and equipment. All loans are reviewed by the IDC committee and recommended to the New Oxford Area Chamber Board of Directors for final approval. I think this membership benefit is very valuable, not only to Chamber members, but the New Oxford community as well.
